






How to help someone learn?

Give someone a fish, and you feed them for a day.

Teach them how to fish, and you feed them for a lifetime.



How to help someone learn?

- Help the learner think
- Ask questions, rather than give answers
- Encourage them to try
- It is never bad to make a mistake



Finding the meaning of a word

Questions you can ask

- Where did you read or hear this word?
- What part did you understand?
- What do you think it could mean?
- How could you find the meaning?



Understanding a text

Questions you can ask


- What is it what you want to learn from the text?
- What part did you understand?
- Where do you think you can find the answer?
- How do you know that?



Understanding an instruction


Questions you can ask

- What is your question?
- What part did you understand?
- What do you think you need to do now?
